Music Provision - Have Your Say

We're currently reviewing our music provision for next academic year, and we would really appreciate your input. Please take a moment to complete this very short survey [HERE](#) to help us shape what's possible.

Our proposed model includes whole-class music lessons led by Mr Evans, covering singing, composing, and keyboard skills, giving every child the chance to explore and enjoy music as part of their weekly learning.

In addition, we are exploring the option of offering small group string instrument lessons for 30 minutes a week on a Friday, focusing on ukulele, guitar and violin. These would be available to ALL children, but to make this possible, we would be asking for voluntary contributions of £7 per week from families who are able to support.

At this time, we are not able to offer drumming sessions, but we are actively looking at options to introduce this in future years. Your feedback will really help us understand interest levels and feasibility, thank you in advance!
