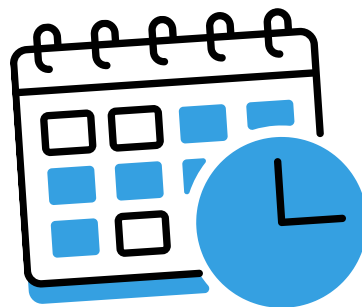

CFSS providers include the Tax Free Childcare scheme and a range of other Government childcare support schemes. Adding the provider or providers you are registered with will enable you to select and use the provider as a payment option when booking onto activities. Please also include your unique child reference (if applicable), as this will help us allocate your payments.

If your provider is not listed, please contact us and we will investigate adding and accepting the new provider.

- Enter your unique reference number in the designated box.
- Once those steps are completed, you will then be able to proceed with booking the selected sessions.
- You will then need to go into your account with your provider and make a payment through there, within 5 days of your booking.
